LE FLASH CURATORS CATHY BYRD + STUART KEELER

A conceptual synapse of light and experimentation in public space, LE FLASH echoes Nuit Blanche, an annual night out for art in Paris, Toronto, Tokyo, Berlin and other destinations around the globe. Atlanta encountered this dynamic for the first time last October. The premiere of Le Flash sparked a moment of phenomenal energy in the city, hinting at infinite potential for the event.

LE FLASH 2009, the opening fête for Atlanta Celebrates Photography, promises an extraordinary encounter in that nether space between lens and light. Rain or shine for one night only, Atlanta reaches for a luminous communal experience of contemporary art.

Internationally known gloATL and Lauri Stallings present a fantastic feature performance designed for the Castleberry landscape. More than 50 projects flare up in vacant lots, empty buildings, galleries and boutiques, sidewalks and street corners, extending to the furthest reaches of district. The scent of lemon flashlights drifts past dancers squeezing their moves into a truck. Zombies and robots stalk a shadow puppet show. Human fireflies flit past an outdoor film screening. A tree ghost rises from a frozen sea. A midnight garden sprouts fire flowers. Horses charge the bridge and a bonfire shoots for the moon. Unlikely intersections in art and performance are to be anticipated.

Our platform for new-genre public art is an expandable model, and the legacy has just begun! We look to you, Atlanta, to sustain and grow LE FLASH—to invest in your cultural life. On October 2, this small district at the edge of downtown flickers and flashes with a fantastic burst

of art on a night invited and propelled by one neighborhood and an anonymous donor. Will the evening move us closer to an annual city-wide event? Consider the dynamic between artists and community that can make this happen. The opportunity is yours!

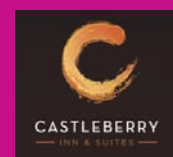

MARTA/PARKING/SHUTTLE

The Green Solution: Park @ Lindbergh, Inman Park or Avondale MARTA Station. Take the train south to Garnet Station. Exit Trinity St. side.

Public Parking available in lots at the intersection of Trinity Ave. and Spring St.

Le Flash Shuttle service is provided every 10 minutes. The route loops from Peters Street at Castleberry Street to Garnett Station, with one stop each way at the Trinity Ave. public parking lot.
